The picture above is of our little apricot tree blossoms. A missionary family living here before us, Bill and Bonnie Reble, planted an apricot tree and from the fruit of that tree started another. Several years ago Gina was able to get another little tree going from that same tree. It's been hard work to keep it going here in the desert, but it's grown into a nice size bush.

It seems the same with ministry sometimes! We plant, we water and we wait. We nurture a little more, water, and wait. Some years we see a great harvest and others, not much of anything. We're thankful God directs our paths, our hearts and minds. HE gives the increase and is in control of it all. If we don't keep this in mind we can quickly get into a downward spiral and end up discouraged.

"In this world you will have trouble..."

The last few weeks have been rough for Mark. In the span of three weeks he's counseled an officer involved in having to shoot a suspect, counseled officers that were on scene of a fatal DUI involving three young kids, and is counseling other officers involved in a shooting that could've ended badly.

The second incident happened as we were heading to the chiropractor. Mark got news about the shooting involving several officers from the district Mark has been ministering in for the last 15 years. These are men and women he knows and sees regularly. When he got the news it didn't sound good. We had flashbacks to his officer friend, Houston, that had been shot and killed in the line of duty a few years prior. After our appointment he rushed back to Crownpoint to get the unit they assigned to him and headed into Albuquerque to check on the two officers who were hit. On his way the unit's transmission died just short of the hospital. Thankfully he was able to get it going again and limped it the rest of the way. When he arrived, he discovered, incredibly, that both of the officers only had minor injuries and would be released after a period of observation. We are SO grateful for the LORD's hand of protection around them during this incident. Even though these were all horrible incidents, the Lord is using it to open doors. We're grateful that even in times of trouble we can "take heart; because HE has overcome the world."
