This May, 27 students finished simple living class. In this class you build a house in the “jungle” and function as a team for 16 days with no running water, cell service, or internet. The planning for this event takes place 2 months earlier. The students are on teams and plan together how to build the houses what food to bring, who cooks, cleans, what happens if its very cold or very hot . this year was very cold a few days and rainy. Wood stoves were quickly built to help the huts stay warmer. What stuff do you need for first aid? How about dish drying rack? Muddy kid’s clothes, how do you clean them with no access to washing machine? These were very good team building classes. Susie and I donated 2 pigs for the butchering class for these jungle dwellers. We then took the leftover bones and meat home ground into ground pork and cut bones for soup bones for later use by students. The pigs were 287lb each.

The end of May 25 students graduated from the 2-year program. It was such a Joy to see new missionaries who will be our future coworkers preparing to go overseas.

Dwayne will have Nose surgery September 8th to correct a very broken nose. He is having problems breathing through his nose especially at night, pray for the surgery and healing afterwards.

Pray for Kegan, he is autistic we are trying to help him get a job to work towards being independent. He has worked jobs in the past, pray for the right opportunity. He is loving his computer classes and working on computers but there are not may jobs available here in Camdenton MO.
