### Observation Questions

1. **FIT** – where does it fit in God’s Big Story? Back then, now, time yet to come?
2. **FOCUS** – SJGR Is it focused on Sin, Judgment, Grace or Restoration?  
God is always revealing sin, warning of judgment, promising grace and moving us towards full and final restoration in His presence. What is the main one(s) focused on in this passage?
3. **FAILURE** – what sins are revealed and addressed – what examples, warnings, rebukes, consequences, and explanations are given – how do we see this today in our culture, our church, our family, our neighbors, our own lives
4. **FAITHFULNESS** – how is God’s faithfulness revealed – His nature, attributes, activity, work, plan and character displayed in this passage?
5. **FAITH** – how are we challenged to believe God, and trust and obey Him for His glory? What are we called to know, think, feel, believe and do?
