Baby hats and quilts have been delivered to our area pregnancy centers. As a Patches of Love group, we have visited our local nursing home and given quilts to the residents in need. A gospel tract and bookmark is included in each item that is package and delivered. We receive cards of thanks from some individuals, but only God knows the full spirited harvest of this ministry.
