We believe that God is calling us to take his Good News to those being currently impacted by periods of intense transition, trauma, and strife within the foster care system and believe that this is the step in faith needed to carry out this mission!

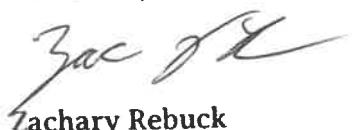
In this, we are scaling back the breadth of campers that we are reaching through our camp program. We now are anticipating and asking that our campers fit into 1 of 4 specific categories: **In Foster Care; In Kinship Care; Adopted/Reunified within a year; Receiving Post-Permanency Services.**

As we look to the summer, we are prayerfully anticipating three weeks of programming, two at Camp Hebron in Halifax, PA and one at Camp Eder just outside of Gettysburg in partnership with Royal Family Kids Camp. Prayerfully, we have even more in the works for 2027 and will share further as details are confirmed!
