Fruit of a Different Kind

But as for you, be strong and do not give up, for your work will be rewarded.
2 Chronicles 15:7

We began this year with the expansion of the temporary church at Matthieu. We were able to add onto the width of the church, but it now occupies the entire lot that is rented. Soon, the search for land to purchase will begin.



The year also began with us receiving news that the gardens suffered a complete loss due to the drought in the mountains. We lost the entire peanut crop. Not even one peanut was able to be harvested. So sometimes in life and ministry, there is loss. But it's what we do in that time of loss that matters most.



We pushed this sad news to the past, and we pressed on. We planted 52 new fruit-bearing trees, including 8 coconut, 14 mango, 3 avocados, 3 soursup, 3 custard apple, 3 Spanish lime, 3 orange, 3 starfruit, 3 mandarin, 3 bergamot, and 6 breadfruit. We hope that the trees in time, will not only bear fruit to be distributed, but will also create shade to protect the gardens planted around them from the harsh Haitian sun.





We're excited to tell you that the newest Bible Club Kafou Kwa has grown to the point where they needed a temporary structure. That construction is currently underway. It is exciting to see another Bible club reach this point. It means another new church plant will be closely behind. God continues to use Bible clubs as an incredibly effective church-planting ministry. We currently fund 10 Bible clubs, with more communities requesting to start one.

If you would like to be a Bible club sponsor, the cost is only \$25 per month. These funds provide 10 children per month to attend Bible club, learn about Christ, and receive a huge hot meal each week. Not all 10 clubs are fully

funded as we move forward in faith that God will provide the sponsors we need. Should you feel God calling you to help financially, you can reach out to us or visit our website, juniperhaiti.org, to partner with us in reaching the kids for Christ. We need 39 sponsors to have all 10 Bible clubs sponsored, which will enable us to take on another village, then another, and another.





We broke ground for the home of a long-time employee named Boulo. If you've been to Haiti with us, you know Boulo. He is a hard worker and one of our gardeners. He lives beside the ministry center. In fact, some of the land for the ministry center was purchased from his wife's family. He is a joy to be around. He has been living in a tarp-wrapped home since the earthquake of 2010. It will be a joy to see him and his family have a solid home with no leaking roof and a cement floor.



It is a great joy in the ministry when we see that the seed planting that is done through the ministry is yielding fruit. We are called to be seed planters. God will harvest. It is a major step in Haiti to receive baptism. This public confession of their faith in Christ shows the seriousness of their desire and commitment to following Christ. Your support does many things. We can build churches, homes, provide food, provide jobs, teach skills, and many other unmentioned blessings to the Haitian people. By far the most important thing that your support brings is spiritual change to the lost and
